



Power Boating Trip Checklist

Power Boat Gear

- Alternate propulsion (i.e. paddle or oar)
- Anchors & Line
- Batteries (fully charged and encased in plastic boxes)
- Bilge device (bilge pump operable, alternative bailing device)
- Bright flashlight or searchlight
- Clothing
- Compass
- Drinking Water (Gallon per person per day)
- Fire Extinguisher (right number, size, and class for boat; charged, not corroded, nozzle clear, bracketed, readily accessible)
- First Aid Kit (i.e. Band-Aids, First-Aid Cream, Campo-phenique (good for minor burns, cuts and scrapes), Tums)
- Food
- Map/Charts (in waterproof container)
- Matches/Fire Starter (in waterproof container)
- Navigation lights & Spare Bulbs
- Personal Flotation Devices (wearable and throw able)
- Pocket Knife
- Sound Producing Device (i.e. whistle, horn)
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Sunscreen Weather Radio
- Tools (spare outboard prop & lock nut; spare trolling motor prop and pin)
- Visual Distress Signals (i.e. current dates on flares, proper number)
- Watch or Clock
