Canoeing Trip Checklist

Basic Canoeing Gear

- Canoe
- Clothing(Quick drying pants, wet suit,caps, socks, shoes, weather dependent)
- Compass
- Drinking Water (Gallon per person per day)
- Emergency Throw Line
- First Aid Kit (i.e. Band-Aids, First-Aid Cream, Campo-phenique(good for minor burns, cuts and scrapes), Tums)
- Food
- Headlamp or flashlight (extra batteries and bulbs)
- Map/Charts (in waterproof container)
- Matches/Fire Starter (in waterproof container)
- Paddle (one per paddler)
- Personal Flotation Device
- Pocket Knife
- Signaling Devices (i.e. whistle, mirror)
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Weather Radio

Additional Canoeing Gear

- Bow and Stern Painters (rope) 20 foot
- Canoe Chairs/Back Rests
- Canoe Repair Kit or "Ding Stik"
- Extra Paddle (at least 1 per boat)
- Float Bags
- Large Sponge (for bailing)
- Plastic Bailer
- Tie-Down Line
